GENERAL QUIZ

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- Two make a team.
- Quiz will be conducted both in English & Kannada.
- The event will be held in two rounds.
- Use of any electronic gadgets is strictly prohibited

- One participant from each college.
 - Participants are requested to be in formal attire.
- Judgement Criteria:** Subject knowledge, problem Solving, Communication Skills and decision-making.

FASHION SHOW

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- **Theme: "Director's Cut: Unspoken Stories"**
- **Team Composition:** 5 to 7 participants per team.
- **Performance Format:**
 - 1.Round 1 (The Monochromatic era): Slow-paced walk in monochromatic outfits with vintage props.
 - 2.Round 2 (The Climax): A high-energy runway walk featuring vibrant, modern fusion streetwear.
- **Timeline & Audio:** 2 mins for on-stage setup + 5 mins max for the performance, driven by a single pre-mixed track submitted before the event.
- **Safety & Compliance:** No use of fire, water, or loose colours on stage.

Judgement Criteria: Theme Relevance, Costume Design, Stage Presence and Choreography

Judgement Criteria: Presentation, Validity of Points, Language and Overall Impact.

PRODUCT LAUNCH

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- Team contain of minimum 1 and maximum 2 members.
 - Present a new and innovative product.
 - Time Allotted: Presentation 3 mins, 2 mins for Q&A.
 - Participants are required to come prepared with their product idea, a PPT presentation (max 10 slides), and a visual representation/prototype (e.g., physical model, digital mockup, or detailed sketch).
 - Product must not be offensive or inappropriate.
- Timings:** 10:00 AM - 12:30 PM

MANAGEMENT ROADIES

Rules and Regulations:

- Four participants make a team.
 - Participants are required to wear sportswear or any comfortable pants and a shirt / t-shirt
- Judgement Criteria:** Creativity, Problem Solving and Team Work.

CORPORATE WALK

Rules and Regulations:

- Two make a Team.
- Theme: "Balance of nature"
- Participants are strictly prohibited from using rangoli powders. To promote sustainability and uniqueness, teams are encouraged to use eco-friendly materials only, such as inedible seeds, leaves, petals or flowers.
- Rangoli must be within a 4ft x 4 ft area provided.
- Time allotted: Presentation 3 mins, 2 mins for Q&A.

Judgement Criteria: Creativity, Neatness, Time management, Theme interpretation.

GAMING

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- 4 make a team with a minimum account level of 25.
- Hacks, mods, or 3rd party applications is strictly prohibited.
- Participants should bring a smartphone with BGMI pre-installed and updated, earphones and a charger.
- Tablets, triggers, and controllers are prohibited

COOKING WITHOUT FIRE

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- Two make a team.
- Teams should prepare 1 beverage, 1 dish & 1 dessert. Pre-cooked items are not allowed.
- Use of electrical or gas appliances is prohibited.
- Participants must adhere to strict hygiene and cleanliness standards, wear headgear and an apron.
- Waste & leftover ingredients must be properly disposed of before leaving. Lack of cleanliness will result in Elimination.

Judgement Criteria: Taste, Presentation, Cleanliness & Hygiene.

REELS MAKING

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- One participant from each college.
- Videos must be captured on the event day and submitted before the allotted time.
- Duration of reel: 45-60 seconds.
- Theme will be given on the spot.

Judgement Criteria: Creativity, Relevance to Theme & Quality.

Timings: 10:00 AM - 12:30 PM

SPORTS QUIZ

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- Two make a team.
- Use of mobile phones, books, notes, or any external resources is strictly prohibited.
- Quiz will be based on topics related to sports.

TRASHION

Timings: 12:30 PM - 2:30PM

Open to All

Rules and Regulations:

- Team consists of 4-7 participants.
- Outfits must be made from waste or recycled materials (newspapers, plastic bags, etc). Costumes purchased or rented will not be considered.
- Teams must ensure that the preparation area allotted is left clean. Failure to maintain cleanliness may result in negative marking.
- Any form of offensive, vulgar, or inappropriate content is strictly prohibited.
- Time allotted is 2+1 mins on stage to present.

Judgement Criteria: Accuracy, Creativity, Costume and Presentation

CULTURAL FEST

BHARATHANATYAM

Timings: 10:00 AM - 12:30PM

Rules and Regulations:

- One participant from each College.
- Pure classical form must be performed (Bharathanatyam).
- Classical music to be used; Remix or fusion is not allowed.
- Time allotted: 4+1 mins, including time for preparation.
- Song must be submitted on a pen drive before the performance.
- Any flammable element, water, or colours are prohibited.

Judgement Criteria: Rhythm, Abhinaya, Costumes, Footwork and Performance.

FOLK SONG (SOLO)

Timings: 11:00 AM - 12:30PM

Rules and Regulations:

- One participant is allowed from each college.
- Time allotted: 3 + 1 minute.
- Songs must be performed only in Kannada, Hindi, or Tulu.
- Participants are not allowed to use karaoke.
- Participants may use non-electric musical instruments. (No additional marks or special consideration in the judging.)
- Obscene lyrics and gestures are strictly prohibited.

MEHENDI

Timings: 11:00 AM - 12:30PM

- Two participants make a team - an artist and a model.
- Design must cover the ventral side of the arm (one hand).
- Mehendi cones/paste will not be provided. Pre-made stencils/references / mimic tattoos are not allowed.
- Duration: 1 hour. Theme: **"Traditional Bridal Elegance"**

Judgement Criteria: Neatness, Creativity and Design.

GENERAL RULES:

- The fest is open for all students studying PUC (11th & 12th).
- Max of 46 participants from each College can register for the Festivals of the Fest & 16 participants for the Cultural Fest.
- One team per College is allowed for each event.
- Registration will begin at 8.00 AM and closes at 9.45 AM on 31st August 2026. Late entries will not be entertained.
- Participants should carry a permission letter and college IDs.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided to the participants and the accompanying faculty. All participants will be given participation certificates.
- Judges' decisions are final.
- Colleges must confirm their participation by August 20th, 2026, and submit the student registration list by August 22nd, 2026
- The best-performing college will be awarded the Overall Championship Trophy, while the second-best will receive the Runner-Up Trophy.

WEALTH OUT OF WASTE

Timings: 11:00 AM - 12:30PM

Rules and Regulations:

- Two make a team.
- Time allotted is 1 hour.
- Readymade items are not allowed. The use of waste materials is encouraged.
- Use of electrical tools/equipment such as glue guns, electric cutters, etc., is strictly prohibited.

Judgement Criteria: Creativity, Uniqueness and Presentation.

THEME-BASED PERFORMANCE

Timings: 12:30 PM - 3:30PM

Rules and Regulations:

- Team consists of 10 - 15 participants.
- Time allotted: 5 min (Performance), 2 min (Stage setting).
- Theme: **"From War to Peace: A Journey of Hope"**
- Character assassination, political party promotion or criticism, or vulgarity in any form is strictly prohibited.
- Songs must be submitted on a pen drive before the event.
- Use of any flammable elements, fire, or water is not allowed.

Judgement Criteria: Theme Relevance, creativity, choreography, coordination and overall performance.

SCIENCE EXHIBITION

Timings: 10:00 AM - 3:00 PM

Open to All

- Two make a team.
- The model can be working or static.
- Students can include a chart in their presentation.
- Language permitted: English and Kannada.
- Spot registration will not be available.

Judgement Criteria: Creativity, Knowledge and Clarity.
