Under the autonomy status, he became the Director of DDU Kaushal Kendra and Campus Minister and was appointed as the Principal of St Aloysius College (Autonomous), Mangaluru in 2017. He is a passionate researcher publishing in renowned journals with a high impact factor and also an NAAC assessor for Autonomous Colleges in India. This prestigious position as the First Vice Chancellor of ST ALOYSIUS (Deemed to be University) will be an opportunity to raise the bar of the 144-year-old institution and enhance its delivery systems and campus culture by imparting education of global standards, and by creating an inclusive ecosystem that caters to the educational needs of students without discriminations
