NATURE CLUB

• Guest lecture on the 'Wild life photography' by Mr.Jeeth Raj and Mr.Rohith of 3rd year journalism B.A of our own college. He explained the mistakes done by the cameraman in wild life photography. Students were made aware of different types of lens used in different photographs. He also showed us the pictures clicked by him of many birds and reptiles.

- Bottle Gardening: Bottle gardening is a process of growing plants inside the bottle with little or no exposure to the outside world. Students were asked to bring seeds of various plants. Two liter bottle was taken and cut vertically into two halves. Each half was filled with soil and water and the seeds were sown and were left to germinate.
- Nature Hike: Forty five students of nature club were taken on a hike to Niddel near Padil to large acres of arecanut plantation. Stream of water ran amidst this plantation. The students were taught techniques of capturing fish with and without the usage of fishingnets. Many ornamental fishes like doctor fish ,crabs, shrimps etc. These fishes were observed , identified and released back into the stream. The students gained a hands on training about the technique of fish capturing and identification.
- Aquaponics: Aquaponics is a system in which the waste produced by the fish supplies the nutrients for plants grown hydroponically, which in turn purify the water. Aquaponics refers to any system that combines aquaculture (raising aquatic animals such as snails, fish, crayfish or prawns in tanks) with hydroponics (cultivating plants in water) in a symbiotic environment. A mini aquaponic system was built by the students using old Bisleri can.
- Paper bag Making: Students were requested to bring bind sheets of paper and demonstration of the making was done during the hour. The cause of the activity was to create awareness to ban the use of plastics and remain ecofriendly.
- Nature Week: The chief guest was Mr.Rohit.S .Rao, the managing trustee of Kudremukh wildlife foundation, a wildlife conservation NGO. He gave the students an insight of his personal experience in the wild and motivated the young minds to join hands with such NGO's and promote conservation. Nature Club also conducted various interclass events such as poetry and creative writing in 3 different languages, quiz, clay modeling, wealth out of Waste, Biologo designing through rangoli, Painting and face painting, collage for students. Around 150 students from all streams actively participated in the events.
