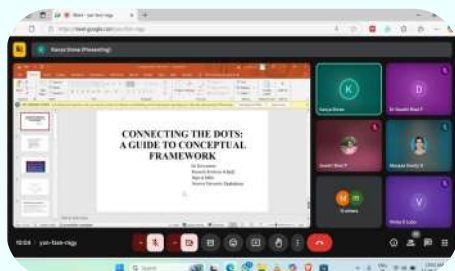


Faculty Development Programme
