Frameworks" on April 12, 2025. Dr. Kavyashree, Head of Department and Research Professor from Srinivas University, Mangalore, served as the resource person. The





was jointly organised by the IQAC, Research & Development Cell, and the Student Research Forum for M.Com students.




ACCA Affiliates


