ployee rights: The role of labour laws' at AIMIT on June 13, 2024. The lecture started with an analysis the role played by labour laws to balance the interests of both the employer and the



employee. Mr Shetty highlighted that labour laws come to the rescue of both the employer and the employee. He narrated the important provisions added in the four labour codes.

It was followed by a brief analysis of the major wage related legislations such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936 and Equal Remuneration Act, 1976. A brief analysis of the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 was conducted during the lecture. 
#### Guest Lecture on Harnessing the Power of Attitude for Personal and Professional Growth




#### Radio Sarang's Report - June
