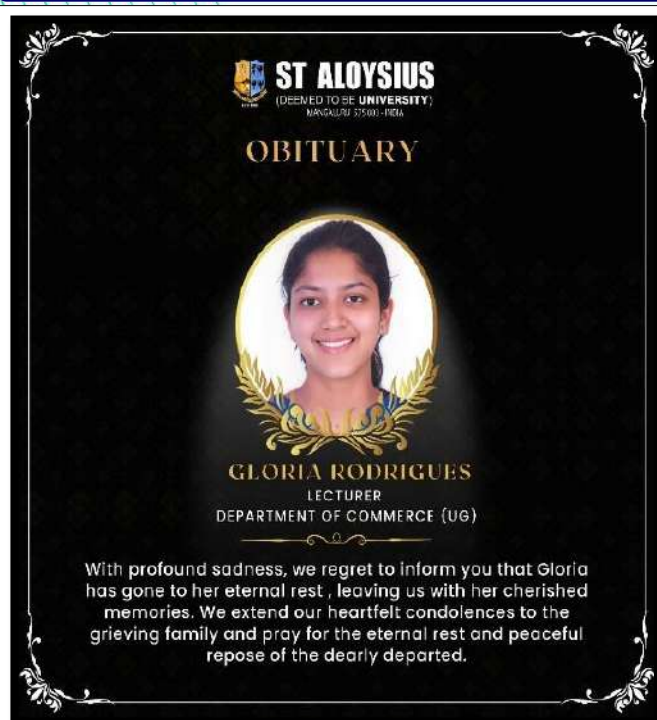
Guest Talk-"From Lithium to Alternatives"

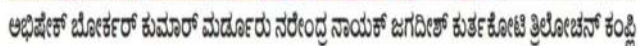

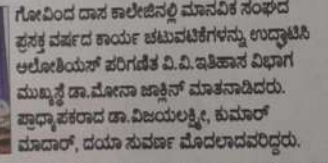

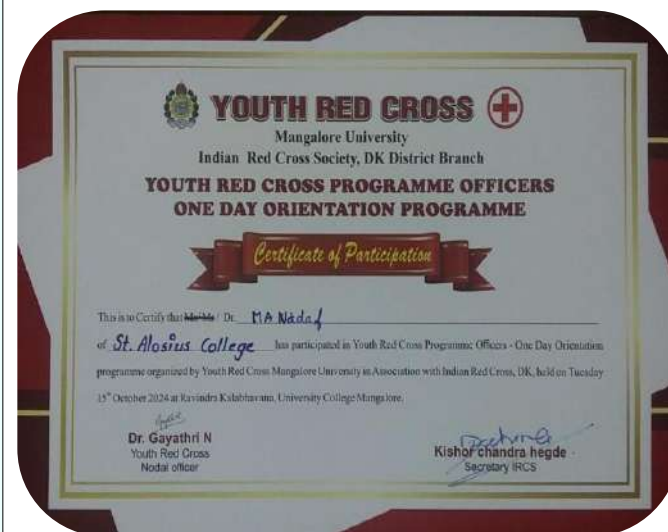
Participation in the 3rd MWIHUR International Theatre Festival
