

Department, Place, Dates and number of Students attended the Rural Immersion Programme: Total of **353 students** participated.

1. **M.Sc Clinical Psychology and M.Sc Corporate Psychology**, 61 students went to Mundgod from 10-15th of November 2025 and they had their Action plan as to work with the children in school. Conduct activities to enhance socio-emotional learning.

2. **M.Sc Food Science and Technology and M.Sc Food Science, Nutrition & Dietetics**, 71 students went to Mundgod and worked as a project to Assess the nutritional quality, hygiene, and food safety practices followed in Anganwadi centres and schools under the mid-day meal programme.
